CORBITT'S COMMENTS

Corbitt's Comments for December 2018

As we come to the end of another year our minds often turn to the past. Before too long we will see retrospective programs on all the news channels looking back at the events from the previous 12 months. I've recently had thoughts of my childhood and particularly something my mother used to tell me. When I would get frustrated or upset and start to act out my momma would look at me sternly and say "Boy, you'd better straighten up and fly right!" But what does it mean to straighten up and fly right? Part of it means to be balanced in our lives and our ministry.

If we are going to straighten up and fly right in our churches, we need to get the balance right between evangelism and discipleship. Dr. Rick Lance, Executive Director of the Alabama Baptist convention has said that evangelism and discipleship are two wings of the same airplane. An airplane must have both wings to fly straight and level and our churches must do the ministry of evangelism as well as the ministry of discipleship if we're going to straighten up and fly right in our church ministry. Our task under the Great Commission is to make disciples, and to do that we must have converts whom we train up in the way they should go in following Christ.

Another factor that we must balance effectively is the relationship between grace and obedience. As Baptist we are firm believers that we are saved by grace through faith and this is a great truth of the Scriptures. It is equally true, however, That Jesus told us if we love him, we must keep his commandments. Some have criticized Baptists for believing in cheap grace, but grace is only cheap if it does not transform our lives into being obedient servants of Christ. In short, we are not saved by our works but when we are saved we are to work for the cause of Christ.

Finally, getting the balance right between the autonomy of the local church and cooperation between churches is a particularly Baptist issue in which we must find balance. Each church is free under the leadership of the Holy Spirit to go its own way should it choose to do so. It is also free under the leadership of the Holy Spirit to cooperate with sister churches of like faith and practice so that together they can accomplish more for the Kingdom of God.

My prayer for us as we closeout 2018 and look forward to 2019 is that we all would straighten up and fly right so that we can enjoy God's blessing on our lives and so that we can be a blessing to him and to the County in which we live
