CORBITT'S COMMENTS

Corbitt's Comments for August 2021

My comments with month are a continuation of a theme that our churches, by and large, are rebuilding their ministries in the aftermath of COVID-19. I have recommended that our churches consider a list of Characteristics of a Healthy Church that the International Mission Board uses to help new churches become mature on the mission field. We could benefit from reflecting on these principles, and we will continue reviewing the in these pages in the months to come.

Last month, we looked at the first four characteristics taught by the IMB: Biblical Evangelism, Biblical Discipleship, Biblical Membership, and Biblical Leadership. Let's look at four more characteristics of a healthy church this month:

Biblical Preaching and

Teaching: Baptists are known as "people of the Word" and rightfully so. The Scriptures are our guide for knowing God and for knowing His will and way. As you will have noticed, all of these characteristics of a healthy church are preceded by the word "Biblical" and that implies that we teach and preach God's Word faithfully so we can know both His standards and His heart.

Biblical Ordinances of Baptism and the Lord's Supper: Some of the few direct commands of Jesus in the Bible include these church ordinances. In fact, these elements of worship were ordained by Christ! They are key elements of a church's worship, and the right and privilege of celebrating them has been given to the church. Churches must be good stewards and practitioners of these so that they retain their meaning and their power of proclamation.

Biblical Worship: Although creation itself is a praise unto God, our Creator wants to hear the praises of His people. Worship is an act, and attitude, and a way of life for the church and all churches should strive to worship God well in accordance with the Word. If a church is growing, and it is impacting its community, but it doesn't worship well, then like 1 Corinthians 13 says about a person without love, it becomes a noisy gong or a clanging cymbal"

Biblical Fellowship: The Bible tells us that, even from the time of the Creation, it is not good for people to be alone. Humankind was made for fellowship, both with God and with each other. Churches should be a place of mutual care and encouragement for its members and those whom they love.

How do our churches measure up in these areas? Now is the time to make improvements!
