We are looking forward to relocating the bookshop to our Sanford office on Highway 84, and we're currently renovating a space for that purpose. We hope to have that completed by the beginning of October but for now we are renting the existing location to continue to serve the churches of our region.

Let me mention that operating this bookshop fits in very well with our strategy, one pillar of which is to Encourage and Equip Churches and Ministers. We believe providing a source of Christian material locally will be a great blessing to our churches and many other churches in our area.

If you want to learn more about this new ministry enterprise, I encourage you to attend our Annual Meeting which is planned for October 21st at Buck Creek Baptist Church. We're looking forward to them serving us a good meal at 5:00 PM and then we will transition at 6:00 PM into doing our necessary business and providing reports of our ministry from the past year. We will cap the night with an inspiring message by brother Jim Kelly and we're looking forward to hearing from him. We appreciate Buck Creek being willing to host us and we appreciate their kind support!
