# **CORBITT'S COMMENTS**

Dear Friends,

One of the chronic issues that we face in the CBA is the number of churches without a pastor. Over the past 11 years there has not been one day during my ministry in this association where every church had a called pastor. We often find that churches have long-term interim pastors, or they have a strong lay leader and so rely on pulpit supply for every Sunday service. The Biblical record, however, is that the sheep need a shepherd. Sadly, it seems like only 42 to 45 of our 52 churches can have a permanently called a pastor on a regular basis.

For the past several years I personally have been praying, and I have asked our churches to pray also, that God would call out more men to be pastors of our churches. particularly our bi-vocational churches. I have no doubt that God has been calling out men but the number who have answered are few. In addition, it's important for God's under-shepherds to study to show themselves approved. I will not denigrate individual study, but I find that a more formal course of study usually works out better for most people.

That's why I would like to reintroduce our association to one of our oldest continuing ministries: the Sanford Ministry Training Institute (SMTI). Our Association has been participating with this means of providing Bible college classes on a local level since the SMTI began 70 years ago. I'm sad to say that in recent years, few of our young pastors in the CBA have taken advantage of this course of study that can provide education here in our own county. It was also disappointing to know that the SMTI was one of the associations least known ministries as reflected in our recent ministry strategy survey.

The sheep need a shepherd, and the shepherd needs to study to show himself approved. The Sanford Ministry Training Institute is an excellent way of doing that and I highly recommend it. I'll be glad to answer any questions anyone has on this excellent Bible training program.
